

Mission Co-op Collection June 18/19

The proceeds from this appeal will be used for the following projects: For the education of the poor but deserving seminarians, whose parents could not afford the cost of seminary education. This year, there are 130 seminarians (65 in High School, 45 in College and 20 in Theology). We educate our High School and College seminarians in our Diocesan Seminaries, while we send our Theology seminarians to Metro Manila, Philippines.

For the establishment and strengthening of our Basic Ecclesial Communities (BECs), which we started last year. The building of our BECs is the focus of our Fifth Diocesan Pastoral Plan for 2009 to 2014. It is organized into a cell of 10 to 15 families. We conduct diocesan conferences and parochial seminars to the leaders of these family cells in order to provide them values formation founded on the Word of God, leadership trainings, good governance, care for the environment and sustainable agricultural livelihood. We give emphasis in forming authentic Christian disciples, the new way of being Church in the Philippines today.
