

EMBRACING CHANGE IN THE LITURGY WEEK 2

Why is there a need for a new translation?

Pope John Paul II issued the third edition of the MissaleRomanum (the Latin test of the Roman Missal) during the Jubilee Year in 2000. This new edition included many new texts requiring translation. In addition, the experience of the years after the Second Vatican Council gave rise to a desire for more formal and literal translations of the original Latin texts. This new translation will employ the best of what we have learned about translation and liturgical language in two generations of celebrating the Liturgy in the vernacular. It will provide an opportunity to reflect even more deeply on the eucharistic celebration that lies at the heart of the Church's life.

What exactly is changing?

The structure of the Mass (the order of the elements, the actions of the priest celebrant, and so forth) remains

unchanged in the new edition of the *Roman Missal*. However, the translation of the prayer texts will change to more closely reflect the original Latin texts. In some cases, new options for prayers may be available, and some old options may no longer be present.

How can I prepare for the change?

There are many ways in which you can prepare for the changes in Mass:

- Make a conscious effort to participate more fully in the Mass each Sunday and holy day.
- Take advantage of any special catechetical sessions offered by your parish or diocese.
- Visit the Roman Missal Web site (www.usccb.org/romanmissal) to study the new texts and to learn more about the changes.
- Read the new texts of the people's parts at Mass. Begin to study them so that you will be able to pray them well when the new *Roman Missal* is implemented.
- Pray for a renewal of love for the Liturgy in your parish and in the Church.
