We will have Benediction at several outdoor altars and conclude here at Corpus Christi Church, with Holy Mass celebrated by Father Ryszard Biernat, the Associate of St. Amelia's. Remember this event is open to everyone; so if you have Children or Grandchildren, especially those who can wear their First Communion attire, please invite them to come with you. Save that day! And we hope to see you there. On this Sunday, there will be only one Holy Mass in the morning, celebrated in Polish language at 10:00 a.m.

Plenary Indulgence – General Conditions

The following "General remarks on Indulgences" from Gift of the Indulgence summarizes the usual conditions given in the Church's law. This is how an

indulgence is defined in the Code of Canon Law (can. 992) and in the "Catechism of the Catholic Church" (n. 1471): "An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints". In general, the gaining of indulgences requires certain prescribed conditions, and the performance of certain prescribed works [in this case, celebrate the Most Holy Body & Blood of Jesus Christ] To gain indulgences, whether plenary or partial, it is necessary that the faithful be in the state of grace at least at the time the indulgenced work is completed. A plenary indulgence can be gained only once a day. In order to obtain it, the faithful must, in addition to being in the state of grace: have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin?; have sacramentally confessed their sins?; receive the Holy Eucharist? (it is certainly better to receive it while participating in Holy Mass, but for the indulgence only Holy Communion is required); pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff. It is appropriate, but not necessary, that the sacramental Confession and especially Holy Communion and the prayer for the Pope's intentions take place on the same day that the indulgenced work is performed. Prayer for the Pope's intentions is left to the choice of the faithful, but an "Apostle's Creed", "Our Father" and a "Hail Mary" are suggested. One sacramental Confession suffices for several plenary indulgences, but a separate Holy Communion and a separate prayer for the Holy Father's intentions are required for each plenary indulgence.

St. Anthony of Padua, Priest & Dr. of the Church

Saint Anthony's Feast Day is celebrated in Church on June 13th. In our chapel on Tuesdays, we've recited the perpetual Novena Prayer of St. Anthony over the years. During the last year, we noticed that the numbers of followers of St. Anthony drastically decreased; too many people stopped participating in this devotion. So, unfortunately on Tuesday June 11th, we will recite the Perpetual Novena of St. Anthony for the last time.
