Special Collection

This will insure that all Catholic men, women and families of those in the Military have access to the sacraments, authentic Catholic information, and the spiritual guidance of a Catholic chaplain, wherever they are stationed. This is a Diocesan Collection.

Significant Week

Fr. Justin Figas will be remembered at Holy Mass to be offered at Corpus Christi Church on October 23rd, 24th, 25th, and Saturday October 26th at 11:30 p.m. All are invited to attend. As founder of the Rosary Hour radio program, Fr. Justin "opened the doors of Corpus Christi" to the entire nation with his weekly message of spiritual guidance, encouragement and hope. His broadcast, begun in 1931, continues as the longest continually running religious radio program in the world. From its earliest days, Corpus Christi parish was committed to providing a solid education for newly arrived immigrant children. This focus helped to ease the transition into their newly adopted homeland and to offer them the best chance to develop their full potential.

The Polish Legacy Project

The Polish Legacy Project will host the annual memorial to All Souls, held on November 2, at 4:00 p.m. at Saint Stanislaus Cemetery Mausoleum, 700 Pine Ridge Road.
