Blessing of Throats

Next week, February 2nd, after each Mass, Father will bless throats. This is a custom dating back to the 8th century, when a child was brought to St. Blaise. The child was said to have a fish bone lodged in his throat and close to death. St Blaise was able to cure the child, after using two Blessed candles held to his throat and Praying for his well-being. Many years later, Blaise was made a Bishop in Armenia, persecution of Christians began again and St. Blaise was guided to hide in the mountains. Hunters found a cave, surrounded by wild animals and recognized St. Blaise. They captured him and he was later executed. St. Blaise is also the Patron Saint of wild animals.

Blessing of Candles

At next week's Masses, February 2nd, Father will also bless candles. If you have your Baptismal Candle, or would like to bring a candle to be blessed please do so. We will have small, used candles, for those who wish to participate and use these instead. Traditionally these blessed candles are burned during times of hardship or stress, or during severe storms.
