#### A Note from the Diocese

In December 2014, the Diocese of Buffalo will launch the Catholics Come Home campaign. In the first six years, Catholics Come Home has aired invitational messages as "evangommercials" in 37 dioceses and nationally, reaching 200 million viewers, thereby helping lead hundreds of thousands home to the Catholic Church. This campaign constitutes a significant expression of our commitment to empowering Catholics for the new evangelization in this diocese.

At the conclusion of the Year of Faith, the Bishop appointed a diocesan commission for promotion of new evangelization. Recently, at the convocation of priests, they considered the importance of new evangelization, with the help of Fr. Frank DeSiano, CSP. Since then, the diocese has directed Dennis Mahaney, in the newly renamed Office of Evangelization and Parish Life, to concentrate his efforts on supporting parish evangelization efforts. The Bishop is asking you join him in the next step-a partnership with *Catholics Come Home* campaign that will begin around Christmas. We will keep you informed of any updates that come through the office.
