### Remembering the Passing of a Loved One

The feast of All Souls Day is approaching very quickly. Once again Corpus Christi will sell votive candles that will burn on the altar rail with your loved one's name on it. If you can't be here; send in your \$5 stipend and name of the person or persons (more than one name can be placed on a candle) you care about and we can make sure it is included on the altar rail. If you choose to come on Sunday, candles for the altar will be sold in the back of the church, along with "thunder" candles, that may be blessed and lit during storms, and small bottles of Holy Water will be available. "Thunder" candles are 51% bees wax and are \$ 10.

### What does the Candle Mean

The candle symbolizes light in the darkness of life especially an individual life, illumination; it is the symbol of holy illumination of the spirit of truth. Its components also have great meaning:

wax - pure flesh or humanity, wick - soul, light - love, divinity, flame - godhead, fire - obedience, heat - humility.
