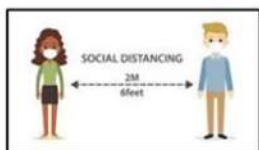

The Ascension of the Lord**

The Feast of the Ascension commemorates Jesus' ascension into heaven 40 days after his resurrection. Thus Ascension Day falls 40 days after Easter, on the 6th Thursday of Easter, but in some parts of the world, the solemnity is celebrated on the Sunday after the traditional date.

The Feast of the Ascension is the Holy Day of Obligation – Masses Corpus Christi Church 8:45 a.m., St. Stanislaus 6 p.m.

**May 13th, Our Lady of Fatima**

May 13 is the anniversary of the apparition of Our Lady to three shepherd children in the small village of Fatima in Portugal in 1917. She appeared six times to Lucia, 9, and her cousins Francisco, 8, and his sister Jacinta, 6, between May 13, 1917 and October 13, 1917.
